



**Crawley Growth Programme**  
**Worth Park Avenue – Cycle scheme**



The Crawley Growth programme encapsulates a number of interdependent priorities that have the objective of achieving growth outcomes in Crawley; these include improved connectivity and accessibility to key places. The Worth Park Avenue cycle scheme contributes to these objectives by:

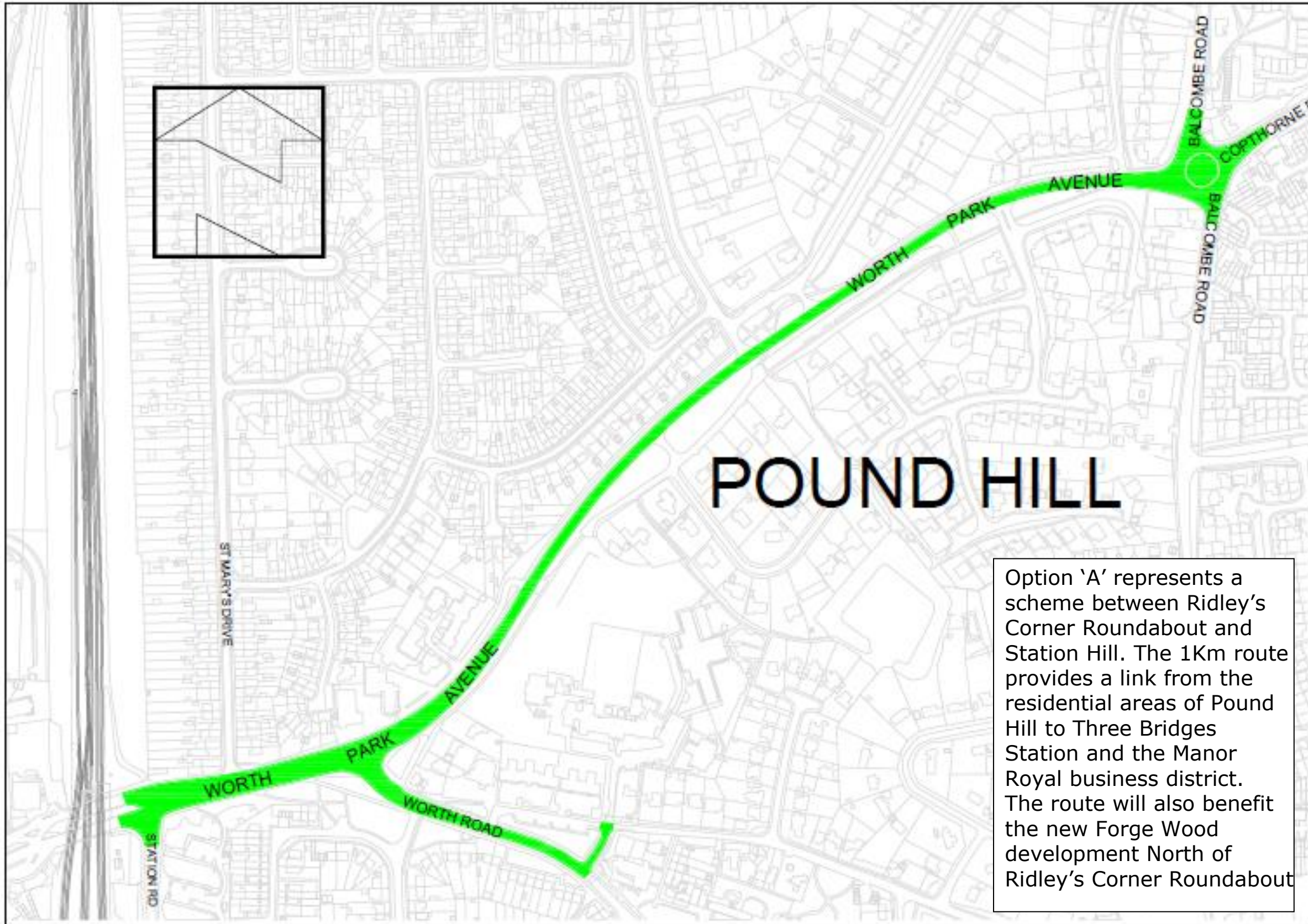
- Facilitating ease of movement
- Promoting the use of sustainable modes of transport.
- Increasing connectivity and accessibility
- Improving safety, access and journey times to Three Bridges Station

This ultimately supports the Future West Sussex Plan core priority of

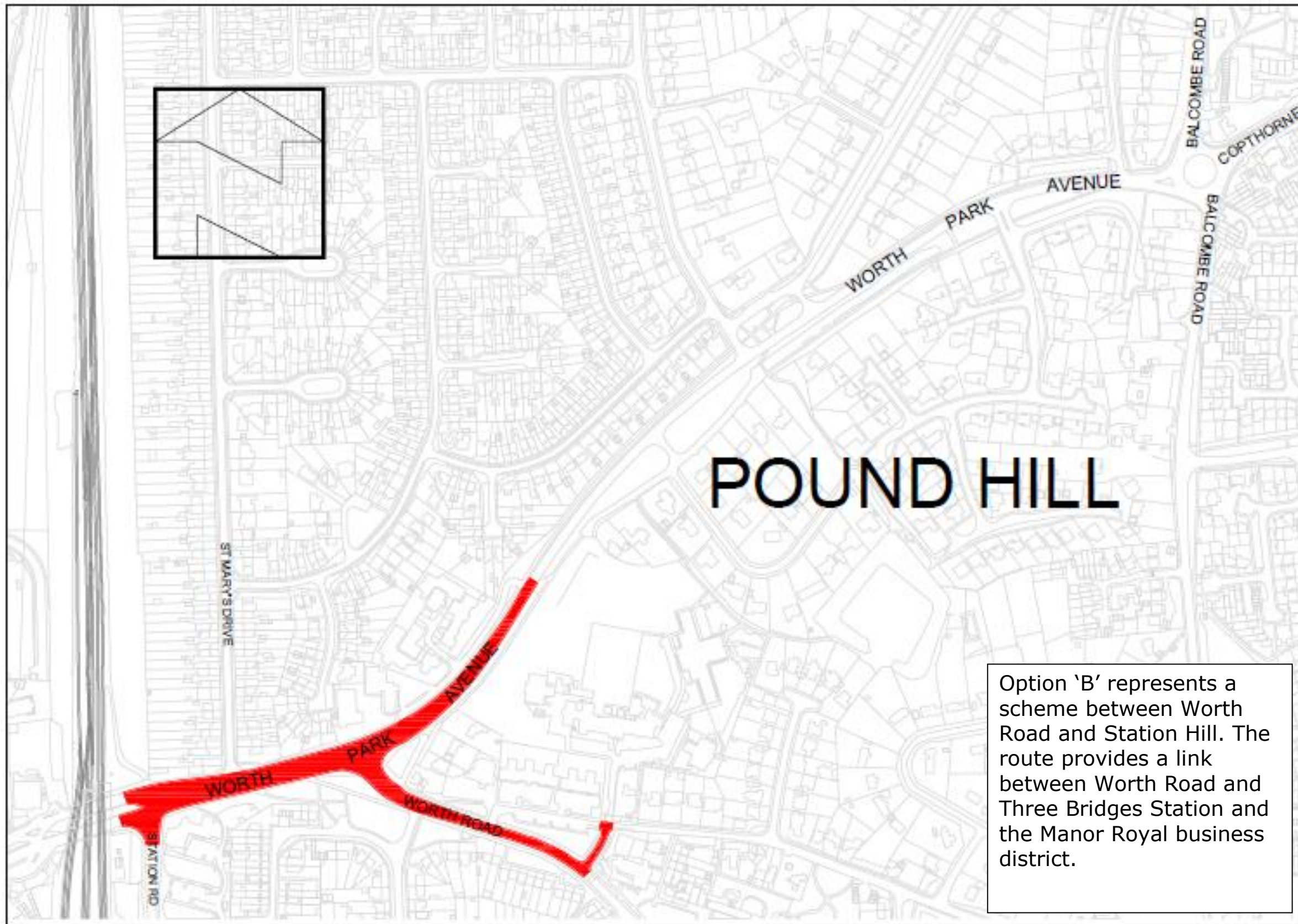
*'Championing the West Sussex economy'.*

The scheme itself delivers 1Km of dedicated cycle facility connecting the key residential areas in Pound Hill with Three Bridges Station, Manor Royal Industrial Estate, and the wider cycle network within Crawley.

# Option B



Option 'B' represents a scheme between Worth Road and Station Hill. The route provides a link between Worth Road and Three Bridges Station and the Manor Royal business district.

## **Option C**

Options 'A' & 'B' represent the best solution for conveying cyclists between Station Hill and their respective start/finish points (Ridley's Corner Roundabout for Option 'A' and just East of Worth Road for Option 'B').

If a scheme to provide these facilities is not deemed necessary then Option 'C' exits as a '*do nothing*' option.
